"An easter egg makes sense only **when it executes**, yet it should be **executed only rarely**."



The First?

In Moonlander (1973), if the player flies far enough from the moon, they encounter a McDonald's restaurant.



<u>The First Cheat Code</u>

The text game Colossal Cave Adventure (1976) introduced the first cheat code: xyzzy.

It was used to skip sections of the game.



The First Arcade!


Starship 1 (1977), one of the earliest arcade games that had an Easter egg, a simple message "**Hi Ron!**", was unknown until 2017.



<u>The First Famous?</u>

Some Easter Eggs are not intentional, like the KONAMI CODE for the game Gradius (1985).

The developer used the code to test the game quickly and forgot to remove the code before release to the Nintendo Entertainment System.

The First Hidden Character?


The first Mortal Kombat (1992) had the first hidden character: **Reptile**.

In the game Hexen (1995), if you use the first Doom cheat codes the character will either die or lose everything.




